Special request - for those of you pond dipping ...please remember to only dip your nets!!!!!! You need to stay dry!!!!!!

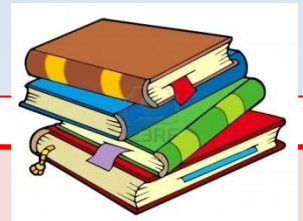
KS2 Play - Matilda
