

Cheadle Primary School Asthma Policy

This school:

- Welcomes pupils with asthma
- Encourages and helps children with asthma participate fully in school life
- Recognises asthma as an important condition
- Recognises the need for immediate access to inhalers
- Ensures the school environment is as favourable as possible
- Ensures all staff understand asthma
- Ensures all staff make children aware of issues concerning asthma
- Understands what to do for an asthma attack
- Will in the event of an attack give emergency treatment when necessary and inform the parents accordingly
- Works with parents, governors, health professionals, staff and children to ensure the successful implementation of the school asthma policy

Guidelines within the school:

- Children are encouraged to be in control of their own asthma medication (blue inhaler) wherever possible.
- Brown inhalers are not to be brought into school but to be used at home
