New Trim Trails and PE Equipment

We are absolutely thrilled that we have now had our amazing new PE equipment signed off by the HAGS installation teams and that they are now ready for our children to put them to good use! The children have all had a special visit to the apparatus and had a clear review of the rules of use. Every child's safety is absolutely paramount and we do not want any child whatsoever having an accident whilst using the equipment. We have therefore set out some very clear ground rules and any child who disobeys these rules, placing either themselves or any other child at risk, will be removed from using the equipment for a period of time until they can be trusted to do this safely.

I do trust that all families will agree with these rules as we really want the equipment to offer all children a fun and exciting learning time. Children can and need to take risks, they need to push themselves to do things that may be tricky and gain a real sense of satisfaction from their efforts.

From initial chats with the children, they are very excited and absolutely chuffed to bits with their new facilities. So, as we are classing the play equipment as an outside learning environment, we have to insist that any younger siblings are kept from playing on the equipment at the end of the day.

The trim trials are age appropriate and we always supervise their usage, so unfortunately any inappropriate use by children after school will not be allowed. If a child should have an accident on this equipment, the school is just not insured. We therefore very kindly ask that you supervise your children whilst on the playgrounds and do not allow them to use either of the trim trials in the interest of safety.
